SAFETY RULES AND OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

SAFETY RULES:

Read, understand, and follow the safety and operating instructions listed herein.

Follow table saw manufactures safety rules for safe operation, keeping all machine guards in place.

Do not use on saws that exceed 4500 rpm.

Wear safety glasses and dust mask at all times.

Do not take too large a cut or force material through sander too rapidly.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS:

- Apply abrasive Disc to beveled side of the EdgeTech II using the 3" raised hub to help apply Disc.
 Squeeze abrasive disc in place, making sure a good bond is achieved over the entire surface.
- 2) Install the EdgeTech II disc on your table saw with the beveled face toward saw fence.
- 3) Rotate saw arbor 2 degrees so that beveled face is at a 90 degree angle to saw table. Raise disc to maximum height and check, using a small accurate square. Reset disc to working height.

NOTE: On table saws that rotate blade toward fence (i.e. Rockwell Unisaw) rotate saw to a positive 2 degree position.

On table saws that rotate blade away from saw fence (i.e. Powermatic) rotate saw to a negative 2 degree position.

Resetting of saw stop may be necessary to achieve this, but is helpful because it maintains the standard blade and saw fence relationship.

4) Set saw fence so that the first pass removes between 1/64" to 1/32" of material. Check operation with sample piece before proceeding.
